Description of Work Performed and Progress: The objective of the research project is to evaluate the influence of a range of asphalt binder types on mixture fatigue for representative environmental regions encompassed by the Pacific Coast Conference on Asphalt Specifications (PCCAS). Professor Carl Monismith of The University of California at Berkeley has completed the testing of the nine binders typically used by PCCAS member states (Arizona, California, Nevada, Oregon, Washington, Alaska and Hawaii). Mix fatigue tests have also been completed using all nine binders and preliminary findings have been shared with the PCCAS at their March 2-3, 2004 Asphalt Committee meeting. The progress report is in power point form and is attached.
