Transportation Learning Network (TLN) FHWA Regional Pooled Fund Study Quarterly Progress Report SPR-3(099)

January - March 2009 (Quarter 3)

There was a variety of leadership and technical training offered during Quarter 3. Each event is listed below with the date, title, length and number of participants. These events reached a total of over 1550 individuals during the three month reporting period. Audience participation came from five states: North Dakota, South Dakota, Wyoming, Utah and Montana.

In January, events included the sixth and seventh sessions in the Personal Finance series—"Kids and My Money" and "Making Good Benefits Choices," a three-day (Jan. 5, 7 and 9) PE Exam Review, a leadership series workshop entitled "Improving Your Ability to Deal with Conflict," a Franklin Covey one-hour Brown Bag video and a day-long Franklin Covey FOCUS workshop. "Pipe for Life" focused on the design, layout, and installation of reinforced concrete pipe. "Work Zone Traffic Control for Maintenance Operations" covered traffic control devices, parts of traffic control zones, typical applications, flagging, and liability.

February training included a three-day Franklin Covey Seven Habits workshop as well as several technical workshops. The "Seal Coat" session focused on an update of the chip seal handbook, what a chip seal is, why chip seals are designed, aggregates, binder, construction methods and fog sealing. "Micro surfacing/Slurry Seals" included what is micro slurry, when should it be used, how it is designed and how to build it. What is FDR/CIR, when should it be used, how it is designed and what is important for inspection was presented in the "Cold in Place Recycling/Full Depth Reclamation" workshop. The final workshop for the month was "RAP (Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement)" offered by the Illinois Tollway. The presentation described the Illinois Tollway's research into increasing the use of RAP in asphalt mixtures.

March events started with the "ATSSA Traffic Control Technician's Course" which provided an introduction to temporary traffic control in work zones for those installing and removing traffic control devices. "Asphalt – Best Practices in Production" was also offered in March. The program focused on best practice in operation to ensure high-quality, consistent mix. "Gravel Roads" offered to its participants a better understanding of the importance of materials, techniques and equipment needed for maintaining and repairing good gravel roads. March's leadership training included Franklin Covey's "The 7 Habits Maximizer," Brown Bag video "5 Questions Every Leader Must Ask," and "FOCUS." Other leadership workshops were "Leading a Successful Change Effort," and the eighth and ninth sessions of the Personal Finance series—"Risk Management" and "Advanced Savings and Investing for When Times are Tough."

Quarter 3 was the start of an academic semester. Students from North Dakota State University, South Dakota State University, University of Utah, and the University of Wyoming enrolled in the "Public Transportation" graduate course offered through NDSU every Monday afternoon.
