The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is the lead Agency for the Transportation Pooled Fund Study TPF-5(282) "Demonstration of Network Level Pavement Structural Evaluation with Traffic Speed Deflectometer." The FHWA accepts the role of lead Agency and agrees to receive, obligate, expand, and manage contributions from participating agencies.

Participating State departments of transportation (DOT) are asked to submit their funding transfer request form (Form FHWA-1576), along with a copy of this memorandum, to their respective FHWA Division Office for concurrence. The Form FHWA 1576 is available on the homepage of the TPF website (www.pooledfund.org). Additionally, participating States should ask that funds be directed to the FHWA office code: HRDI-20. The Financial Manager of this pooled fund study is: Chris Shehade and the Budget Program Activity Code (BPAC) number is 040TPF5282.

Non-Federal contributors to TPF-5(282) can be made via Pay.gov, which is a system provided by the U.S. Department of Treasury, to make secure electronic payments to Federal Government Agencies. To contribute non-Federal funds to an FHWA-led study, the contributing organization or State DOT may do so by following the following steps:

1. Go to the homepage, www.pay.gov
2. See the section "Find Public Forms" on the left side of the screen. In the box entitled "Search Public Forms" type the word "FHWA Pooled Funds" and press enter.
3. Click on the listing "Federal Highway Pooled Funds"
4. Fill out the form to complete the electronic transfer.
