

States have transferred funds for the Transportation Pooled Fund Study “Web-based Traffic Data Visualization and Analysis Tools” solicitation number TPF-5(280). A Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) is in place and duties may include but not limited to drafting and approving the project work statement, selecting the best qualified researchers to conduct the project, review of project progress reports and annual reports, acceptance of project deliverables and final reports and completing implementation activities. If vacancies occur in the TAC the project partner from which the vacancy occurred is to appoint a new technical expert within 30 days of the vacancy occurring.

TAC members should expect to participate in all project-related meetings and briefings. Advanced communication technologies (i.e., conference calls, webinars, and videoconferences) will be used to the greatest extent possible to participate in meetings and briefings, and reduce the need for unnecessary travel.

The TAC members should participate in monthly teleconferences, quarterly Webinars and a minimum of two paid in person meetings to be held in Washington, D. C. for the Kick-Off in November or December this year and in Chicago, Illinois at NATMEC June 29, 2014 at 8:00 am.
