The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is closing the HOV/Managed Use Lanes Pool Fund Study project TPF-5(029). Effective immediately, participating States and Local Agencies should no longer obligate funds to this project number.

A new project entitled HOV/Managed Use Lanes, TPF-5(322) has been established to replace TPF-5(029). The FHWA Office of Transportation Management accepts the role of Lead Agency and agrees to receive, obligate, expend, and manage contributions from participating States and Local Agencies. These States and Agencies should work with their Local FHWA Division Office to transfer funds they have committed for the current fiscal year to the new project number. They should submit their funding transfer requests on form FHWA-1576, along with a copy of this memo, to their respective FHWA Division Office for concurrence. The form is available on the homepage of the TPF website ([www.pooledfund.org](http://www.pooledfund.org)). Additionally, participating agencies should ask that funds be directed to the FHWA office code: HOTM-1, BPAC 070.
