This refers to Mr. Arthur E. Hamilton's memorandum of September 4, 1990, discussing a proposal to establish a Regional Pooled Fund Study entitled "Midwest States Pooled Fund Crash Test Program."

The Regional Pooled Fund Study is hereby approved and you are authorized to proceed with the study using 100 percent HP&R funding without State matching funds. The assigned study number is HPR-3(017).

It has been determined that this proposed study is part of NCP Program Area A5, Design. Mr. Michael Freitas, HSR-20 is the program manager. The NCP eight digit code for this study is 4A5B1202. Mr. Charles McDevitt has been designated as the Washington Office contact to provide technical assistance for this study. There are several national crash test efforts currently being monitored by Mr. McDevitt, so he is uniquely qualified to provide technical input as needed. We would appreciate the opportunity to technically review proposed designs before actual testing. This will ensure that there is no duplication of effort with the national programs. We hope that we will have the occasion to attend the technical committee meetings and actual crash tests as an observer and technical resource as travel funds permit.

It is noted that you have appointed Mr. William Wendling as Field Project Advisor (FPA). Your office has approval authority for subsequent actions related to this study in accordance with current directives including the new 23 CFR Part 420, "Highway Planning and Research Program Administration", which was effective August 29, 1990.

Please have the participating State Highway agencies execute the appropriate document for placing HP&R funds under agreement and input this information to the Financial Management Information System (FMIS). A copy of the PR-2 should be sent to HRD-10.

Please advise us if we can be of further assistance in conducting the study.
