- Project 4 (NIMS for Frontline Transportation Workers): Completed in September 2009.
- Project 5 (Component Level Risk Management Introduction/Familiarization): Copies of the course and instructions for use and information security were delivered to state DOT training coordinators on 22 November 2010. Project complete.
- Project 6 (Security and Emergency Management Considerations for Highway Planners): Solicitation was conducted and contractor was selected.
