Work Accomplished

The following is a list of major activities during the reporting period:

January 2006

- Brought Bala Sivakumar of Lichtenstein Consulting Engineers on board to address the LRFR issues resulting from '05 SCOBS. Their budget is \$90,000 of which \$15,000 comes from the AASHTO publication budget as in internal transaction. All \$90,000 is chargeable to M&M's project.
- Answered occasional inquiries of LRFD provisions.
- Prepared a list of issues arising from panel comments on NCHRP 12-52 curved girder specifications for T-14 to review at their February meeting.
- Revised PDF queries file for the Movable Bridge Specifications for the T-8 Committee.
