The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is closing the Transportation Management Center Pooled Fund Study (TMC PFS) project SPR-2(207) and TPF-5(052). Effective immediately, participating States should no longer obligate funds to these two projects.

A new project entitled Transportation Management Center, TPF-5(319), has been established to replace TPF-5(052) and SPR -2(207). The Office of Transportation Management accepts the role of lead agency and agrees to receive, obligate, expend, and manage contributions from participating States. Participating States are asked to work with their FHWA Division Offices to transfer funds that they committed for the current fiscal year to the new project number. They should submit their funding transfer request form FHWA-1576 along a copy of this memo, to their respective FHWA Division Office for concurrence. The form is available on the homepage of the TPF Web site (www.pooledfund.org). Additionally, participating States should ask that funds be directed to the FHWA office code: HOTM-1, BPAC 070.
