As a Transportation Pooled Fund Project, the "Superpave Regional Center, Southeastern Region" is funded by 100% State Planning and Research (SP&R) funds. This project has been assigned number 930-763P in our research series and TPF-5(228) under the Transportation Pooled Fund Program.
