The Federal Highway Administration's (FHWA), Office of Planning, Environment, and Realty (Office of Planning) will serve as the lead for the Transportation Pooled Fund (TPF) Study TPF-5(431) on the <u>Applications of Enterprise GIS for Transportation, Guidance for a National Transportation Framework (AEGIST)</u>.
